Making Your Life Count

Christal Fisher's husband died and I went to the funeral. I went to support Christal. I didn't know her husband Terry. I wasn't able to get to the wedding last May. Christal and Terry were only married for a little over a year. I only got to speak to Terry once or twice over the phone. Terry knew there was a possibility he would die from the cancer he had for the last 18 months.

The minister at Terry's funeral read off a list of things Terry did in the last year of his life. They were things that, if I knew I was dying, I don't think I'd have the guts to do. For example, in January he went to Honduras to do church missionary work. It is a difficult trip for those of us who are in good health. Terry did the trip with advanced cancer. He got married to Christal too and he went to work every day and did his job and he was elected an elder of his church, all while he was dying from cancer.

Although I didn't know Terry, I know he was an uncommon man. Most of us, if we heard a diagnosis of cancer, we would go underground. We'd be paralyzed with fear. Terry not only maintained the life he had before the diagnosis, he reached out and grabbed more of life.

So I guess the message is what are you grabbing out of life this year? What are you doing to further the world you live in? Are you playing it safe? If you are playing it safe, is it time for you to get on with grabbing more out of life? I know it's time for me to swing out.

The lesson I took from Terry's death last year of life is: nothing is so bad in your life and no fear so great that you shouldn't reach out for more of what life has to offer.

To Christal, her family and Terry's family I want you to know I got the message and I hope that knowledge comforts you in your loss.
