Taking Care of Aging Parents

As we meet with some of you in workshops we find you are facing the same thing we faced 10-20 years ago; Taking care of parents who cannot take care of themselves anymore.

This will probably be the hardest job you will ever do. For those of you with children you will be stretched to your limit of caretaking. You also have the opportunity to spend time with parents and to have your children learn many lessons for their future.

First, you will need research support systems in your area or your parents area. Anything from hospitals to support groups. We suggest you begin by enlisting the help of people who may have just recently been through a similar experience. Then identify what services for the aging exist around you and your parents.

Second, if you have children make sure they know what is happening in an age appropriate way of course. They will need to know what is making you unhappy or stressed so they don't think it is you. Charlie was in middle school when his grandmother died and a senior in High School when his grandfather died. He was a big support to his grandparents as well as Adam during those times. He and Adam also needed time with us to talk about how they were feeling about their grandparents aging. We HAD to make time for this and so will you.

Third, if you have siblings get them on board with you about the future. Make sure you are agreed on all next steps. If you don't have the support of siblings, as in my case, make sure you have a support group of friends and professionals around you. Pay for the help if need be. It will help you survive this difficult experience in better shape.

Fourth, remember you must make time for YOU during this. If that's escaping for a day or spending time with a spouse or partner or children do it!!!

Finally, you must remember that you are doing the best you can and therefore you have nothing to be guilty for. If you need John or I to remind you of that contact us we will!

We recommend Rosalind Carter's book on caretaking. It was written many years ago but we feel it is still the best. The article in the June 18, 2007 Newsweek is also good especially if you are taking care of parents with Alzheimer's.
