There is a section called "Home & Family" written by Sara Schaefer Munoz. She was reporting on a new "logical decision model" developed by a student & professor at Duke's School of Business.

Sara reports that it was designed to help women "determine the optimal time to conceive by balancing the benefits of motherhood against its effects on career and social interests and organizational concerns".
